




While the word, insān (man, human), in this ayah denotes humankind as a species, the root word, nisyah, describes a characteristic referring to the non-physical nature.






## Sundus

'Green' is the most refreshing color to the eye; like the leaves on the trees, and fits in well with the 'Garden'.




