

Tasbih is to make something float (Glorifying Allah [Swt] and not saying anything not befitting Allah's Grandeur) – in other words, that which floats does not drown. On several occasions in the Holy Qur'an, Allah's Glorification (Subhan) has appeared in response to someone saying something not befitting Allah (SwT).
