ABOUT THE SURAH

Sūrah Fātir, a Makki sūrah, is the 35th sūrah in the Holy Qur'an. It is in the 22nd Juz and is the 5th and the last of the Hamidat sūrahs. The sūrah has 45 ayaah, 780 words and 3,228 letters. Considering its size, this sūrah is among Mathani sūrahs about one hizb (a quarter of a juz').

Sūrah Fatir is about the resurrection, situation and difficulties of the Day of Judgment and repentance of disbelievers. It also warns mankind of deceitfulness of Satan and life that can lead to become astray. Blessings of God are also mentioned in this sūrah and it recommends people to say prayers, spend for God and recite Qur'an as valuable deeds.

Ayaah 01-17 Humans' life is managed only by God

- God manages the life of humans
- Rejection of God will lead to punishment
- Instances of the management of humans' life by God

Ayaah 18-35

Only the pious people will believe in God and His Prophets (A)

- Influence of prophets' warnings
- Prophet's (S) speeches did not have any influence on disbelievers
- Disbelievers have always rejected prophets
- Only knowledgeable people believe in Divine signs
- Rewards for supporters of God
- Chosen individuals will learn the truths of Qur'an
- Rewards for the chosen individuals

Ayaah 36-45
Obstinate refusal of God
and Prophet Muhammad (S)
by disbelievers

- Punishment for opposing Qur'an
- Worshiping anything but God will be harming
- Obstinacy of disbelievers in worshiping anything but God
- Hubris disbelievers did not believe in Prophet Muhammad (S)
- Disbelievers should learn from the fate of the descendants

MERITS

According to the Holy Prophet (S), if someone recites Sūrah Fatir, three doors of Heaven will invite him toward itself on the day of Qiyamah, and he can enter from any door he desires.
