
Sūrah al-Qalam is the 68th sūrah of the Qur'an. This Makki surah is in the 29th juz and by order of revelation it is either the 2nd or the 5th surah. It has 52 ayaah, 301 words, and 1,288 letters. With respect to its volume, it counts as one of the mufassalat sūrahs; it is about half of hizb of the Qur'an. Since this Quranic sūrah involves the word, "al-Qalam" (pen) in its first ayah where God has sworn to the pen and what is written by it, it came to be known as "Surah al-Qalam". And since it begins with the disjoined letter, "n" (nūn), it also came to be called "Sūrah al-Nūn" or "Sūrah Nūn wal-Qalam".

It is the 29th and the last Qur'anic sūrah which begins with almuqatta'at (disjoined letters), and the 10th Qur'anic sūrah which begins with oath.

Its contents include assuaging Prophet Muhammad's (S) worries about accusations made by polytheists against him, asking him to be patient, prohibiting him from following the polytheists, and reminding him about their punishments after the resurrection. The ayah 51 of this sūrah, known as Wa In Yakad ayah, is known as the ayah of evil eyes.

According to a hadith, if someone recites this sūrah in his obligatory or recommended prayer, God will protect him against poverty, and he will be immune to the pressure of the grave. According to another hadith, the reward for reciting Sūrah al-Qalam is equal to that of a person the fulfilment of whose wishes is postponed by God. It is also said that if this sūrah is written on something and is put on a damaged tooth, one's toothache will calm down.
