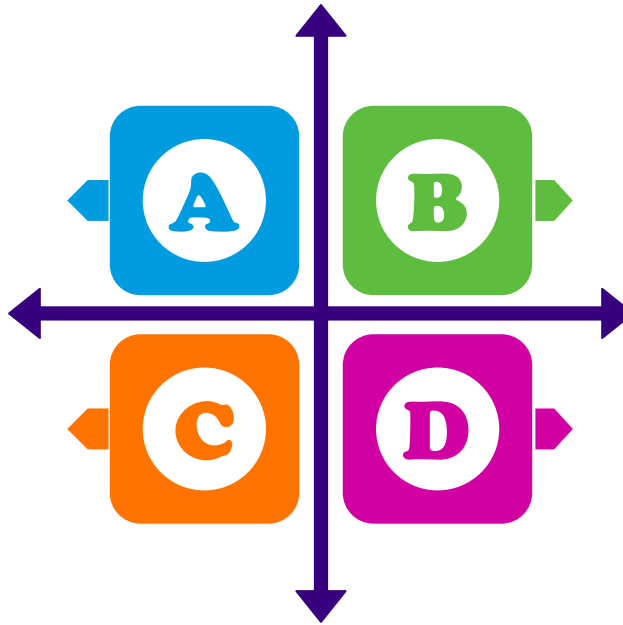

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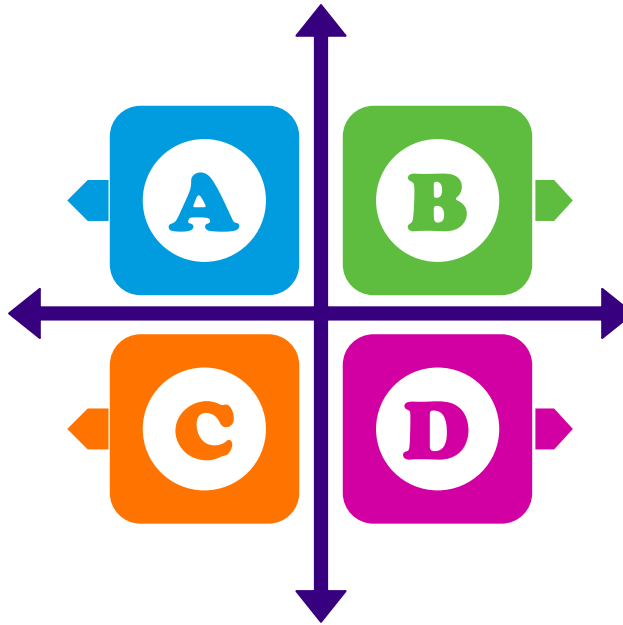

The believers will be exonerated of all evil-doing of the past and the future.

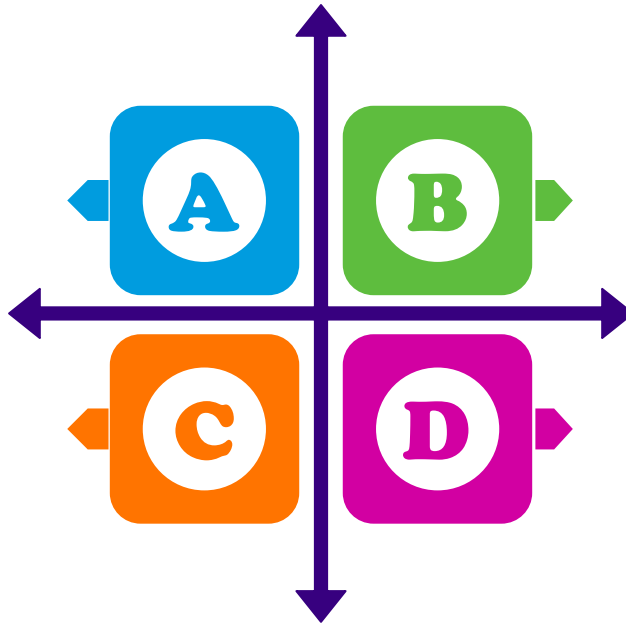
